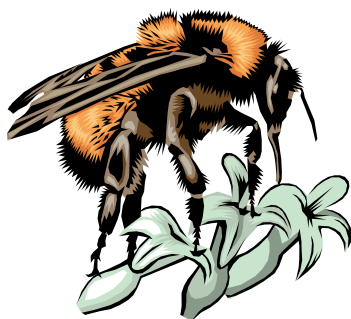
Sponsors & Exhibitors Needed!
