SCHOLARSHIP IN RESOURCE CONSERVATION**

OBJECTIVE

The objective of this scholarship is to provide assistance to a graduate student pursuing a master's or PhD in conservation or a conservation related curriculum at an accredited institution of higher education in North Dakota.

AMOUNT

The amount of the scholarship is \$500.00. Also, the recipient will be invited to attend the 2009 ND Chapter Soil & Water Conservation Society's Annual Meeting with the registration fee waived.

ELIGIBILITY

Applicant must:

Have demonstrated integrity, ability, and competence in work (paid or volunteer,) and possess skills gained (not necessarily in resource conservation) through training or experience.

Show interest in a natural resource related field.

Have successfully completed a bachelor's degree at an accredited college.

Have accumulated a grade point average of at least 2.75 on a 4.0 scale.

Be working toward a master's degree or PhD in a natural resource-related field of study; (natural resources management, biology, plant science, soils, water quality, geology, agro-forestry, agricultural or civil engineering, or other majors involved in soil and water conservation)

Previous employment in a natural resource conservation area is not required but is highly desirable.
